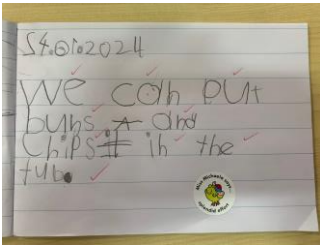

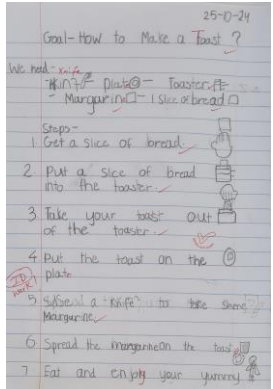
A Message from Miss Schinella

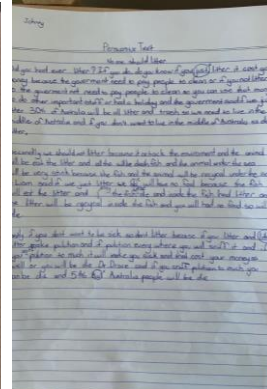

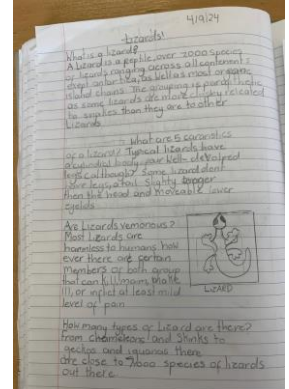

A Spotlight on Learning

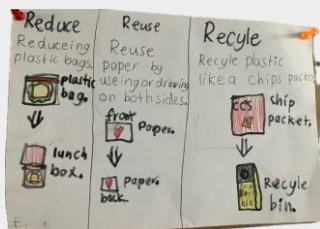
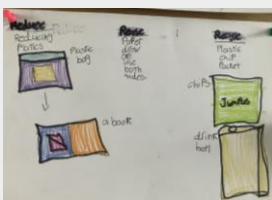
