CanTeen was set up by a group of young cancer patients in 1985 and still have young people affected by cancer guiding the organisation. Through CanTeen, young people learn to explore and deal with their feelings about cancer, connect with other young people facing similar issues and if they have been diagnosed themselves, CanTeen provides treatment teams.
